Zip Disk: 100 MB





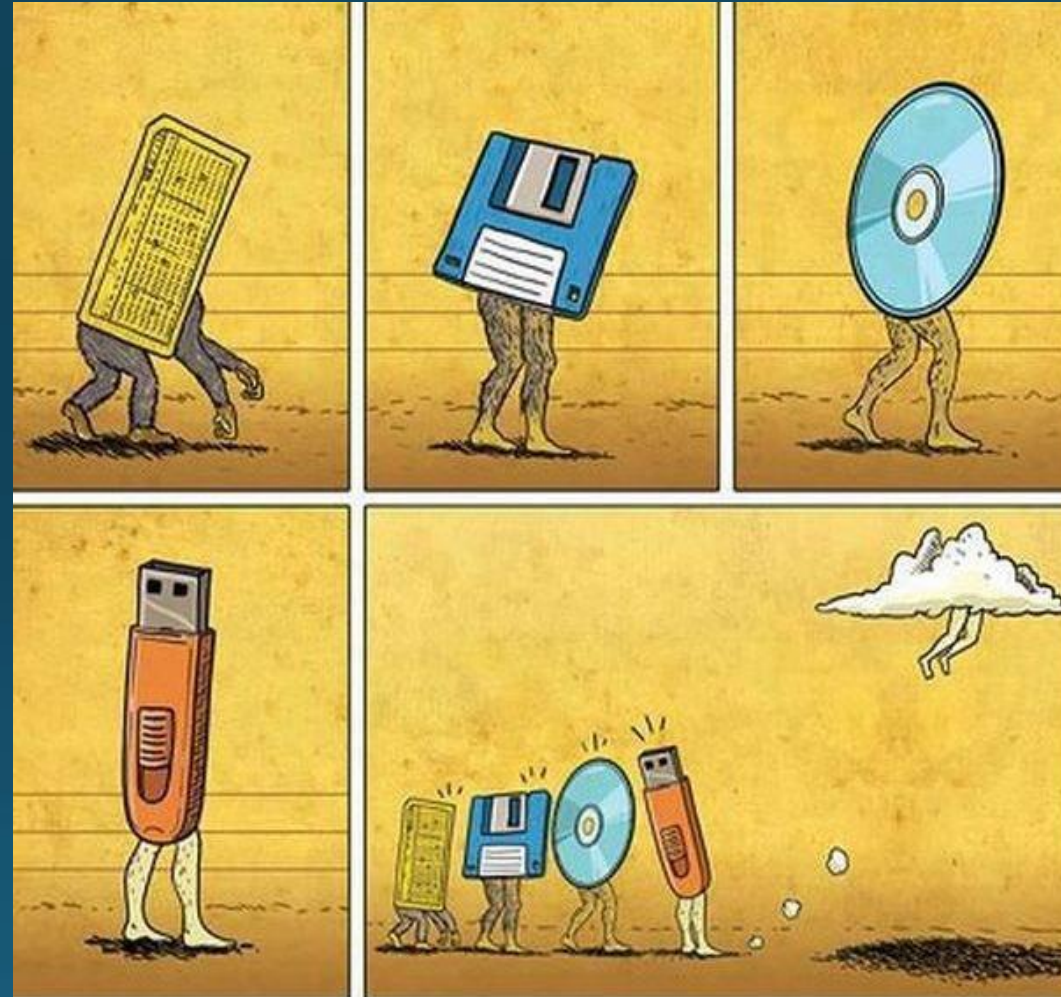
## Then the USB Drive

# Cloud Storage: Pros and Cons

## Pros

- Sync clients mean data parity
- Data is backed up
- Safe from local disasters
- Versioning
- Convenient to retrieve (in most cases)

## Cons

- Syncing can sometimes slow machine down
- Syncing can take a long time on slow connection
- No internet, no access

  - Google Sheets
  - Google Slides



# Microsoft OneDrive

- Free for Office 365 users
- 1 TB of storage
- 10 GB Max file size
- Versioning limited to Office files
- Sync client for Windows and Mac\*
- Clients for Android, iOS and Windows Phone
- Integrates with online Office 365 apps:
  - Excel
  - Powerpoint
  - Word

# Dropbox

- 2 GB free (inviting friends can earn you up to 16GB of storage space)
- 1 TB available for \$99/yr or \$9.99/mo
- 300 MB Max file size (via web); no limit using sync client
- All deleted and previous versions kept for 30 days (Extended Version History available for \$39/yr)
- Sync client for Windows, Mac and Linux
- Clients for Android, iOS and Windows Phone
- Photo Storage tools

# iCloud

- 5GB free for iOS and Mac users
- Additional storage available:
  - 20 GB - \$0.99/mo
  - 200 GB - \$3.99/mo
  - 500 GB - \$9.99/mo
  - 1TB - \$19.99/mo
- 15 GB Max file size
- Versioning is app-dependent
- Sync client for Windows and Mac
- Native client for iOS; 3<sup>rd</sup> party for Android
- Integrates with online iWork suite:
  - Keynote
  - Numbers
  - Pages
- Photo Storage/Editing tools

# CrashPlan

- Available for \$60/yr (individual); \$150/yr (family)
- Provides continuous backup
- No Max file size
- Retains newest version:
  - The last week
  - The last 90 days
  - The last year
  - Previous years
- Client for Windows, Mac and Linux
- Clients for Android, iOS and Windows Phone
